The academic year 2022:23 was hectic in Planning and organizing various academic activities under the banner of various portfolios headed by each faculty member of the college so the CPI was able to organize some of the activities which are summarised and noted below.

- (1) A.G. Teachers College organized pedagogical competitions aiming to Grasp Inventive teaching maths, accountancy, and methodology for Trainee-teachers of all education colleges across Ahmedabad city under the aegis through the launch of the Centre for Pedagogical Innovation from 08:45 am onwards on 10th October 2022. (4) Tranees of the semester: 2 participated in the Commerce Exhibition on 1st April 2023. The main objective of the program was to provide live(practical) demonstrations connected with daily life situations for their teaching career. 14 participants prepared charts, with pictures, models working models, products, documents, specimen copies, and online PPT presentations through different websites.
